Economically, Ethiopia is one of the world's fastest growing countries. The overall economy has registered a remarkable growth during 2003/04-2015/2016. Real GDP on average grew at about 10.6 percent per annum over the last thirteen consecutive years (2003/04 and 2015/16). Forecast by IMF and other credible international Institutions confirm that Ethiopia will continue to register fast economic growth in the years to come.
